Caution is urged as we wait to see if the house will be vacated as requested by the land owners by mail to the tenants. Other incidents include suspicious people "casing" the neighborhood's some approach residents at their home to judge the house's contents and the availability of owners whether day or night. Packages have been stolen off porches since Dec. 2010. Report ALL suspicious people at the PDX non-emergency # 503-833-3333.

Report the blue pickup if you see it speeding through SB as the police want to talk to the owner of this vehicle which is around 13<sup>th</sup> and Hume.

Everyone at the meeting agreed to get on board to MAP OUR NEIGHBORHOOD for crime prevention and emergency preparedness, look for more on this in the spring when we will need everyone's help.

Sandy Morgan Transportation committee rep brought to our attention the CITY WIDE SUREVEY on the backside of your Curbsider mail – Please do the survey as it links our neighborhood to future police, sewer and storm water services from the City.
