Boogied 'til the stars came out! ... 2,700 people filled Willamette park to enjoy the concert in the park series!



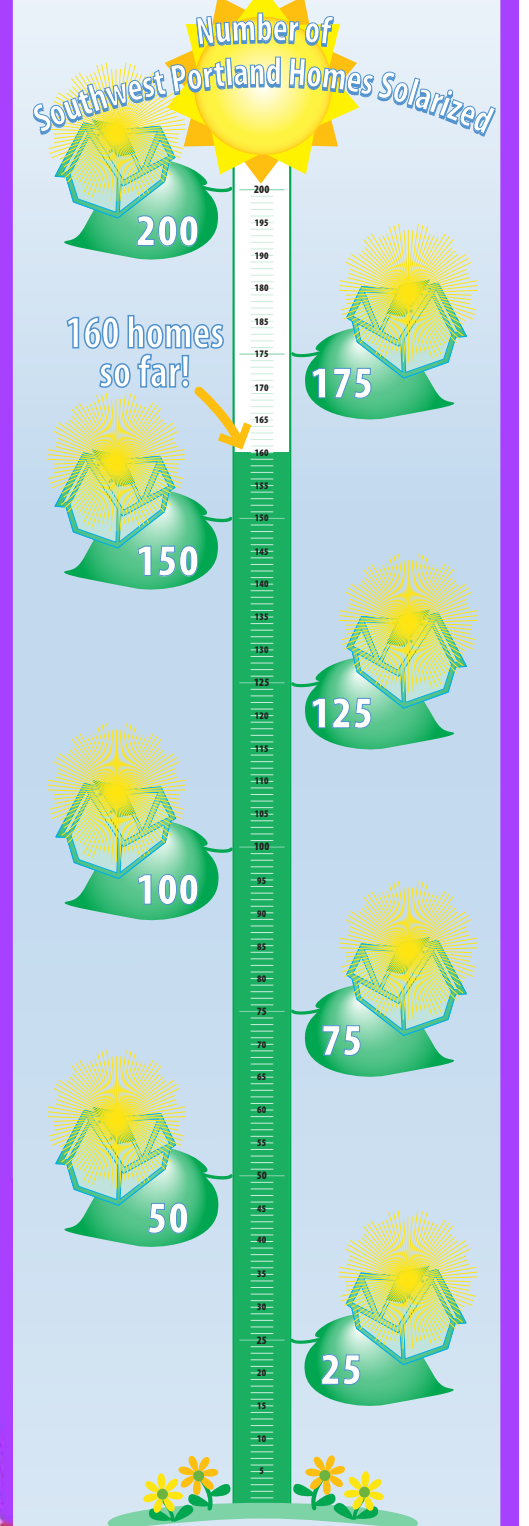
Played in the park... 180 neighbors had a playdate in Spring Garden Park and enjoyed nature-based play activities.
