### **Transportation/Trails/Transit**

- Continue to advocate for expanded TriMet service
- Consult with SWTrails on trails work in SWHRL, and advocate as appropriate, SWHRL liaison to SWTrails: Sean Baioni, back-up: Ryan Fedie
- Respond to City on any transportation issues that arise: Hazards? Opportunities?

### **Land Use**

- Continue to respond to land use notices from the city, advise neighbors on such issues
- Monitor short term rentals, demolitions and other issues in SWHRL and respond as appropriate

### **Communications/Outreach**

- Maintain/enhance SWHRL webpage
- Publish Viewpoints quarterly newsletters, hard copy and E-Viewpoints, plus special E-bulletins as needed
- Contribute SWHRL news to SWNI monthly newsletter
- Maintain SWHRL Membership list, newsletter and email lists
- Find new ways to reach out to and engage neighbors, enlist members
- Create SWHRL flier describing what SWHRL is and does
- Create Welcome packet?
