Amendments to Articles of Incorporation of Southwest Neighborhoods, Inc. (SWNI)

Article I

Name and Duration

The name of this corporation is the Southwest Neighborhoods, Inc., hereinafter referred to as SWNI, or, the CORPORATION and its duration shall be perpetual.

Article II.

Purposes and Powers

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To provide a facility for education, research, and an exchange of information for the citizens of southwest Portland as they may relate to their total environment.
2. To assist in furthering activities and projects that will raise the level of the total southwest Portland environment to that desired by its citizens.
3. To do and perform all of the activities related to said purposes, to have and enjoy all of the powers granted and engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 65.
4. This corporation is organized exclusively for educational, scientific, and charitable purposes only.
5. Notwithstanding any statement of purposes or powers aforesaid, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of its specific and primary purpose.
6. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit or be distributable to its members, directors, or any private individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on:

(a) By a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law)

or

(b) By a corporation to which contributions are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue law).

Article III

Provisions in Event of Dissolution

In the event of dissolution of this corporation, after adequate provision has been made for payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, its remaining assets not being required by law or conditions imposed by any donor to be otherwise applied or distributed, shall be disposed of by the Board of Directors to such organization or organizations organized for purposes similar to those of this corporation and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue Law). Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Multnomah County, Oregon, exclusively for such purposes, or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article IV.

Members

Neighborhood associations formally recognized by the City of Portland, Oregon, Office of Neighborhood Involvement shall be eligible for membership. A SWNI member neighborhood association shall hold membership in no other area coalition of neighborhoods. Membership applications shall be submitted to and must be approved by a 2/3 vote of the SWNI Board of Directors present.

Article V.

Directors

1. The affairs of SWNI shall be conducted by a Board of Directors consisting of one representative from each SWNI member, the chairs of standing committees, elected officers, and one representative from each business association affiliated with SWNI.
2. Business associations wishing to affiliate with SWNI must submit an application, which must be approved by a 2/3 vote of the SWNI Board of Directors present.
