## Volunteer Meal Providers

### SUNDAY SUPPER

**Volunteer Meal Providers bring and serve a hot meal on Sunday evenings for approx. 150 people:**

- Meal to be served from 7:00 to 8:30pm
- Provide disposable plates, napkins, utensils, serving utensils
- Meal items shall be prepared offsite and brought to the Shelter in disposable serving trays

### SACK LUNCH

**Volunteer Meal Providers bring approx. 150 sack lunches:**

- Volunteers to deliver between 6:30 and 9:30pm; can be a one-time donation, weekly, or once a month.
- Provide a lunch meal in a paper bag that can be left unrefrigerated; e.g. of types of food - peanut butter/jelly sandwich, fruit, chips, crackers, nuts, etc...
- Items shall be prepared offsite and delivered

## In-Person Volunteers

### TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE

**Transportation Volunteers work directly with Ride Connection to help transport guests to and from the Sears Shelter:**

- Volunteers will pick-up a Ride Connection van in the parking lot of the shelter on SW Multnomah Blvd; there will be early morning and early evening opportunities.
