## Schools are **Big** Business

- 28 K-12 schools serve over 8,000 SWNI kids
  - 11 public inside SWNI, including 1 charter school
  - 5 public outside SWNI area serve SWNI kids
  - 12 religious and other private schools

If Portland Public Schools was a City Bureau it would be the biggest bureau in the city –
\$620 million/year vs \$1.7 billion city budget
